The original kitchen was designed primarily with aesthetics in mind with very little upper storage. A storage room/scullery located behind the hood wall was the home to several of the appliances and most of the storage for the kitchen. The ovens were also located in this windowless space. For such a large room with 12" high ceilings, the hood seemed dwarfed in the space and a large stainless refrigerator and beverage center surrounded the sink window, consuming any storage offered on the sink wall.

With the new homeowner desiring more of a chef's kitchen, the scullery was torn out and the space was added to the main kitchen. State-of-the-art appliances were incorporated into the kitchen including separate wall ovens both at a perfect ergonomic height, a built-in coffee system, microwave, warming drawer, cooktop, Teppanyaki flat grill, double downdrafts, and a pot filler faucet. Upper cabinet storage was added, with glass doors and decorative mullions for a bit of flair and cantilevered stainless corner shelves for a bit of interest. A massive island with a quartzite waterfall top adds a great prep space and opportunity for the homeowner/chef to visit with guests while entertaining.



#### ABOUT THE KITCHEN

Our client's 1994 6,000 sq. ft. home is a blend of contemporary and traditional architectural styles featuring a large, open floor plan. Unfortunately, the spacious kitchen and breakfast room were outfitted with low-grade cabinetry, fixtures and appliances and faced issues with inadequate storage, an undersized island, and a misplaced closet and laundry room, all of which showed 21 years of use.

Our client wanted an elegant, functional chef's kitchen, featuring ample storage space and refrigeration, more island work space, and better functionality for both day-to-day living and entertaining.

The new kitchen was designed with custom cabinetry, a 48" range, and custom hood. A luxuriously sized island with a farmhouse sink was added, featuring overhang seating and an integrated 4x6 breakfast table. Perimeter cabinetry now boasts generous storage and an abundance of quartz countertop space, plus a supporting butler's pantry and mudroom. The homeowners are thrilled with their preparation alternatives: convection or steam ovens, gas burners, a grill or griddle or a microwave drawer, and the ever toasty warming draw. Increased storage space was provided by utilizing an auxiliary stacked W/D and a mudroom-style wardrobe with storage nooks. The kitchen design features exquisite cabinetry for serving items, more countertop space, a supplemental prep/cleanup sink and refrigeration drawers.



This renovation marks a very special shift for the homeowners as they approach being empty nesters. They were ready to create a space that is a true reflection of their style and personality, while incorporating their love for the low country.

In order to achieve this look, the space was opened so that the kitchen worked as the center of the whole main floor. Walls across the back of the home were all converted to windows to maximize light. Wood-clad ceiling and aged brick walls were added to bring the low country into the home. The light colored cabinetry and butcher block island add a balance of light and warmth against the new medium brown floors. All the latest in appliances including the concealed steam oven were used to create a chef's cooking experience. The Butler's pantry, which is tucked into the new dining room, serves as the beverage station for the family and transitions the dining room from a rarely used to daily space. Finally, the lighting, which is a mix of aged lanterns and an antique chandelier, add character to the space and the classic furnishings that flank the space create comfort while the soft fabric palette adds to the peaceful space.



Soaring ceilings and clerestory windows created incredible architectural drama and hierarchy to this space and presented a challenge in making the kitchen feel comfortable. The navy blue La Cornue and the mixed metal hood anchor - the 16-foot tall wall balancing the keeping room fireplace at the opposite end of this 36-foot long room. Bleached and stained cherry cabinetry and slabs of marble extend upwards to ten feet while framed panels of antique mirror reflect the light and view from the clerestory windows above. A large blue lacquered island is the primary prep space with clean up and dish storage and small appliances are hidden behind pocket doors on the window wall overlooking the covered porch. A working pantry holds another oven, steam oven, freezer, sink, dishwasher and even a small induction cooktop. Dual entry glass hutch doors allow access to dishes from the hall leading to the dining room and from within the working pantry. The combination of multiple cabinet finishes along with the Calacatta Capri marble, walnut stained floors and eating bar, brass and stainless hardware and hood, and iron light fixtures and windows complete the comfortability of the kitchen.

This stunning chef and prep kitchen was designed as part of a 2015 custom home project. The focal point of the main kitchen is the extra-large island, which sits 8, and features a 48" professional range top. This allows the homeowners to cook while entertaining family and friends. Two freestanding custom cabinets on either side of the window are used as china cabinets and made with doors from an old school's windows in South Georgia.

The "prep" kitchen is separated from the main kitchen with 9-light French doors. This division closes off messy work areas and undesired views. The ceilings were dropped in the kitchen area and constructed with tongue and groove wood. Lowering the ceiling made the space cozier and made the living room ceiling grander by contrast. 
