#### **Journey to Literacy**

Journey to Literacy helps raise awareness within the community on the importance of early childhood education and teach parents effective methods to develop and increase early literacy skills.

#### Handmade by JLA

Handmade by JLA volunteers work throughout the year to handcraft or assemble a variety of items to provide aid, comfort, and happiness to clients of our community partners.

#### **JLA Advocacy**

For over a century, JLA has served as a powerful advocate for women and children in the city of Atlanta. Guided by our public stands, a series of affirmative position statements that provide a framework for the League's advocacy, JLA members monitor and support relevant legislation, serve on city-wide Coalitions, and research critical community needs.

#### October 2023 | Literacy Walk

The third annual Literacy Walk is a family-friendly event that encourages participants of all ages to go the extra mile for literacy.

#### February 2024 | 26th Annual Tour of Homes

The Tour of Homes is JLA's reimagined exclusive self-guided tour of homes showcasing Atlanta's industry-leading designers. Participants will experience culinary and event demonstrations, as well as pop-up vendors at each home. A VIP Dinner will take place the week of the Tour.



#### December 2023 | Poinsettia Sale

The JLA Poinsettia Sale offers members and friends the opportunity to purchase holiday items such as red, white or pink poinsettias, tree toppers, and wreath bows. A percentage of the sales support the work of the League.



#### March 2024 | Toast of Atlanta

Toast of Atlanta is a festive and fun night out! Featuring a DJ, this event highlights the local food scene. We will have a live and silent auction with access to bid on exclusive items, trips, and packages!



#### January 2023 | Little Black Dress Initiative

The Little Black Dress Initiative "LBDI" is an awareness and fundraising campaign where JLA members wear the same black dress for a week. Participants are encouraged to harness the power of social media and their networks to share relevant data on the reality that generational poverty places on choices, opportunities, and access to resources for women and children in Atlanta, and while soliciting donations for the JLA on individual fundraising pages.



#### April 2024 | Spirit of Voluntarism Luncheon

The Spirit of Voluntarism Luncheon will feature a keynote speaker to inspire women on the power of voluntarism. JLA will honor external partners and members with awards, and disperse the annual gift to a local nonprofit through our Donor Advised Fund.

**General Membership Meetings -** September 2023 | February 2024 | May 2024

More than 300 members gather together at our General Membership Meetings to hear about the state of JLA and listen to inspiring speakers.

We offer certificate courses in critical volunteer skills that more than 100+ of our members participate in annually.
