About the Kitchen

This kitchen was remodeled as part of an extensive whole-house renovation project. The homeowners were not happy with their existing kitchen, but did not consider a new kitchen in this phase of their project. The HammerSmith design team proposed a kitchen makeover that was easy on their budget and yet drastic enough to make a stunning "new" kitchen. Though the cabinets were dated, HammerSmith was able to reconfigure, rework and repaint them. They put in a new backsplash, new appliances and new fixtures. The most striking feature is the 2½ inch thick marble island top. The perimeter cabinets have a darker leathered granite that adds a soft, warm look.

HammerSmith changed the lighting and created an adjacent office by walling off an odd alcove. They also designed the breakfast nook with a custom reclaimed oak table and banquette. The result is a dynamic, fresh new look that no one would ever imagine was built on the bones of an old kitchen.

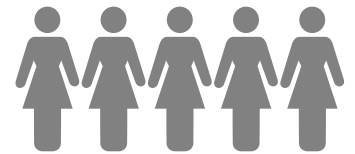
